

Adalah's Training Course for Lawyers on Representing Detainees in Detention and Investigation Procedures

Adalah is seeking participants in a four-day training course for lawyers to be held in Jerusalem on "Representing Detainees and Detention Procedures". The course is intended for experienced lawyers and those who wish to hone their skills in representing Palestinian detainees in Israeli courts and military courts in the West Bank.

The aim of the course is to provide participant lawyers with greater knowledge of the tools of Israeli and international law in "security cases," with an emphasis on the practical aspects of representation. The course will consist of 10 sessions held over four days. Each session will be led by leading lawyers and other experts in issues including: the right to legal counsel; the legal and medical aspects of torture and other prohibited investigatory methods during detention; violence by the security forces and the detention of demonstrators in military and civil law.

The course will be held in Jerusalem on these dates and times:

The number of participants is limited and priority will be given to lawyers with experience in representing detainees, and/or who have concrete plans to do.
